### NASCAR DRIVER TO PARTICIPATE IN TAMPA BAY LIGHTNING GAME-DAY ACTIVITIES

## Justin Allgaier, Sponsored by TradeMark Nitrogen and BRANDT, to Appear at NHL Game December 5

TAMPA, Florida (December 2, 2013) – NASCAR driver Justin Allgaier, fresh off a fifth place finish in the NASCAR Nationwide Series championship standings, will be part of the game-day activities at the Tampa Bay Lightning vs. Ottawa Senators at the Tampa Bay Times Forum on Thursday, December 5. Allgaier will be signing autographs during intermissions and immediately before the match, with face-off and television coverage on SUN at 7:30 EST.

The 2008 ARCA Racing Series champion, Allgaier recently finished his fifth full-time season in the NASCAR Nationwide Series. He grabbed one Coors Light Pole award and five top-five finishes in 2013, finishing fifth in the season-ending championship point standings. He also made his Sprint Cup debut at Chicagoland Speedway on September 15 in the No. 51 BRANDT Chevrolet for Phoenix Racing. He competed in three additional Sprint Cup races, with a best finish of 23<sup>rd</sup> at Talladega Superspeedway.
